Verse

9 Am C C6/G E

Sun so bright and sun so strong Our day's com-ing it's the day of the sun

13 Am C C6/G E Am

Sun's gon-na shine for us all day long Our day's com-ing it's the day of the sun

Verse 2: Sun goes down, here comes the wind
The moon rose full and the moon just grinned
Wind rolls in when the sun is gone
Wind keeps going til the break of dawn

Chorus, Verse 1, Chorus, Verse 2, Chorus

* *NOTE:* One option for C6/G: play a C chord, but move 3rd finger to the 6th /low E string. (Or just play a C chord)

For Chorus, in bars 3, 7, 11, 15—can substitute improvised lyrics for "Our day's coming." Some ideas:
